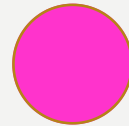

## Through Platform Nine and Three-quarters

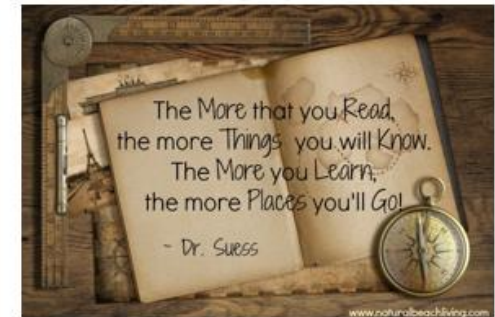

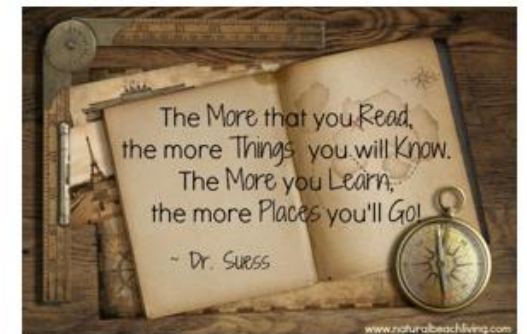
