- Hair should be a natural colour and should be worn without excessive decoration such as bows or bands.

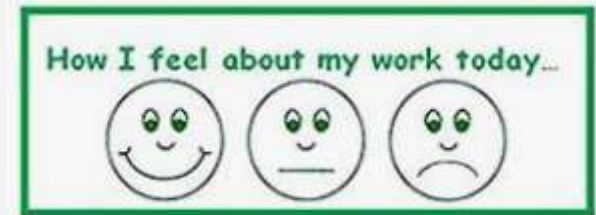


RESPONSIVE TEACHING
