



Dear Parents/Carers

Over the last few weeks we have been monitoring the current situation regarding the Coronavirus – COVID 19 and increasing hygiene precautions in school including ensuring hand sanitiser gel is available in every room and the importance of hand washing and using a tissue. Please ensure you are reinforcing these lessons at home:

**DO:**

- ✓ **wash your hands with soap and water often - do this for at least 20 seconds**
- ✓ **always wash your hands when you get home or into school**
- ✓ **use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available**
- ✓ **cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands)**  
**when you cough or sneeze**
- ✓ **put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards**
- ✓ **try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell**
- ✓ **do bring your own water bottle to school**

**DONT:**

- X do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean**
- X do not enter the school if you have a cough or high temperature and do not return to school for 7 days, NHS guidance is to self-isolate for 7 days**

If you think you might have coronavirus, have been to a country or area with a high risk of coronavirus in the last 14 days or you've been in close contact with someone with coronavirus isolate yourself and ring NHS 111.
